

- LSC conducts research about the state of civil legal needs in the United States.





County-Level Summaries Do Not Tell The Whole Story


- We have collected over 110,000 eviction cases filed from 2016 through the present.
- We estimate over 26,000 eviction filings in Shelby County each year between 2016 and 2019.
- This is roughly 16.6 eviction filings per 100 renter households.
- These numbers belie the racial and socioeconomic disparities in evictions.




Concentration of Eviction Filings in 2019




Low-Income, Predominantly Minority Census Tracts Experience Higher Eviction Filing Rates



Relationship Between Race/Ethnicity and Eviction is Consistent Over Time




Some Tracts Experience Consistently High Eviction Filing Rates



Outstanding Judgements Highlight the Long-Term Financial Burden of Evictions




Weekly Eviction Filings in Shelby County During COVID-19, Jan-Sept 2020

What we see:

- Shelby County is not an outlier. The patterns we see here are patterns that exist in other parts of the country.
- Tennessee has an opportunity to lead the nation by leveraging available data to target resources in an impactful manner.

Future work:

- Community Partnerships: LSC is looking for opportunities to partner with local communities to build tools that leverage court data to understand current need and build targeted strategies.
